Validation of professional experience is subject to absolute approval by the Graduation Jury, based on recommendations from EDHEC's Career Centre.

If a SGH student has accomplished an internship during their Bachelor or Master studies this may be accepted provided it meets EDHEC's requirements. Prior work experience or a full time job abroad or in France is eligible to meet internship criteria in accordance with guidelines set out by our Student Career Center. Students requesting an internship waiver or equivalency, send the internship/work contract together with the application form to the EDHEC Student Career Center.

SGH double degree students at EDHEC complete the Master seminar and Master thesis at SGH.

Successful completion of the SGH Master Thesis must be proven by sending a complete and official SGH transcript to EDHEC showing its successful validation in order to be able to validate the EDHEC Master Project in equivalency.

The anti-plagiarism check report result is sent from SGH to EDHEC according to the EDHEC internal procedures required for awarding the EDHEC degree
